The purpose of the University of Calgary Family Medicine Resident Support Program is to assist with the expenses of residents who are doing a core rural rotation in Yukon. The Government of Yukon provides funding to the YMA for reimbursement of these expenses.

Eligibility for support must be approved by the coordinator of the program; Dr. Huy Chau (867-668-4065 or huy2121@hotmail.com). **Requests for support must be approved before travel arrangements are made.**

Guidelines:

- 1) Receipts - must be provided (except for #4)
- 2) Travel - Advance booked, round trip airfare from Alberta to Whitehorse. Advance booked round trip travel from Whitehorse to rural Yukon community. MAXIMUM OF \$1000 per resident
- 3) Accommodation - rural Yukon community accommodation, MAXIMUM OF \$420 per resident (Whitehorse accommodation is provided).
- 4) Additional Expenses - food, local vehicle rental, etc - \$700 per resident
- 5) Request must be received within 3 months of the end of the elective
