## Visiting Speakers

### **Dr. Ewan Affleck**

Ewan Affleck currently serves as the Senior Medical Advisor - Health Informatics, College of Physicians & Surgeons of Alberta. He is the past Medical Director of the Yellowknife Health and Social Services Authority, Clinical Director of Family Medicine at Stanton Territorial Hospital, and Chief Medical Information Officer of the Northwest Territories. A graduate of the McGill School of Medicine, and Dalhousie University where he studied history, Ewan Affleck has worked and lived in northern Canada since 1992. A digital health information systems expert, he pioneered the implementation of an enterprise electronic medical record system in the Northwest Territories that is unprecedented in Canada in its level of integration. He is passionate about developing sustainable health services for northern communities. In 2013, he was appointed to the Order of Canada for his contribution to northern health care.

### **Dr. Yanick Beaulieu**

Yanick Beaulieu is the Chief Executive Officer & founder of Innovative Imaging Technologies and creator of the Reacts platform, a secure, integrated, collaborative platform with unique and unparalleled interactive tools designed to suit the multiple collaborative needs of healthcare professionals and patients. He is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Medicine at the University of Montreal and a practicing cardiologist-echocardiographer and critical care physician. Yanick is a member of national and international guideline committees for bedside ultrasound in intensive care units and has published many articles on the subject.

### **Lea Bryden**

Lea Bryden has been the CEO at the Medical Society of PEI since January 2014. Prior to that she served as a vice president in the Halifax health authority for over 15 years. As the CEO of the Medical Society, she is most proud of the organizational transformation that has occurred and the professionalism that has now become its hallmark as it pursues a number of new ventures. These include a master's program in physician leadership; taking a holistic approach to physician burnout; working with government to overhaul physician recruitment; and adopting interest-based negotiations to renew the current master agreement.

### **Dr. Deepak Kaura**

Deepak is the Chair of the Board of Joule, a Canadian Medical Association subsidiary. He also serves as the Chief Medical Officer at 1Qbit, a quantum computing software company, based in Vancouver, BC. Prior to these appointments, Deepak spent 5 years in Qatar with the Sidra Medical and Research Center, most recently as the Executive Chairman of the Foundational Clinical Services Management Group, where he helped to set new standards in patient care for women and children and led ground-breaking work in the application of machine learning to

healthcare. Deepak has also served the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada as a Subspecialty Chair in Pediatric Radiology and has established a number of startups in the healthcare space. He has received his MBA from HEC Paris, FRCPC following training in Calgary, and his MD from the University of Manitoba. He has held faculty appointments as Associate Professor at Cornell University and the University of Calgary.

#### **Dr. Sonny Kohli**

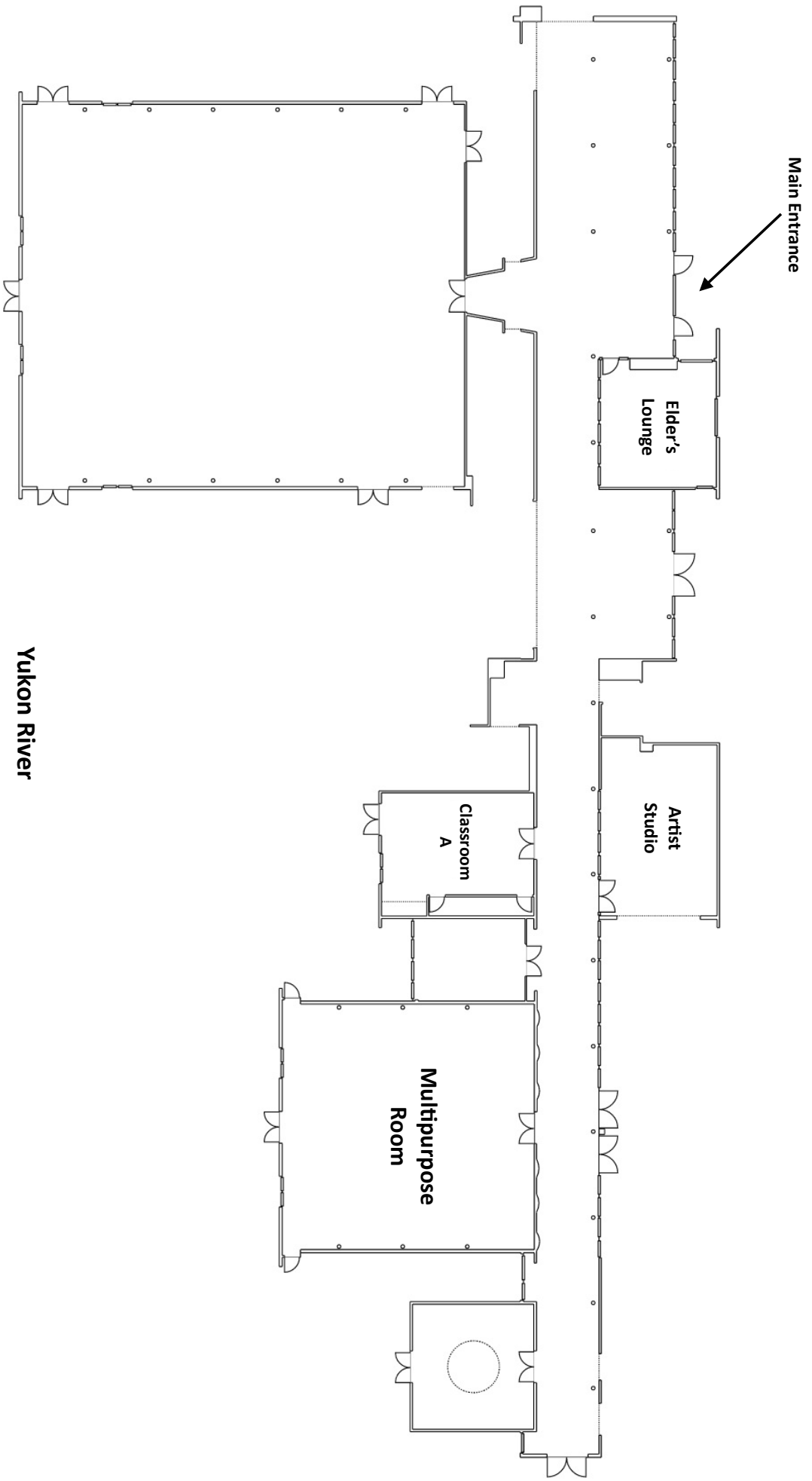
Sonny Kohli is the Co-founder and Chief Medical Officer at Cloud DX Inc., a provider of remote patient monitoring hardware and software. He is also a founding faculty of Healthcare at Singularity University Canada and an Associate Professor (adj.) at McMaster University. Sonny led Cloud DX to Canada's first ever XPRIZE award, creating a "Star Trek" inspired medical tricorder that was bestowed with the "Bold Epic Innovator" award in the Qualcomm Tricorder XPRIZE competition. Sonny is formerly a Canadian Space Agency astronaut candidate, trained Flight Surgeon, and alumnus of the International Space University, where he helped deploy the IRIS experiment on the International Space Station.

#### **Deborah Scott-Douglas**

Deborah Scott-Douglas is Interim President at Joule and Vice-President, Innovation at the Canadian Medical Association (CMA). Leading the design and implementation of innovation strategies and projects with a focus on social innovation, Deborah has been an integral leader in CMA's transformation to an agile organization. As Interim President for Joule, Deborah will seek to create synergies in innovation across the enterprise, leading the design and implementation of innovation strategies and projects in support of our strategic plan, CMA 2020. Ms. Scott-Douglas holds a BA in history and political science from the University of Alberta and a Masters in Library and Information Science from the University of British Columbia. During her career she has worked at the University of Cambridge in Cambridge, England; the University of Alberta in Edmonton, Alberta; and at the Organization of Economic Cooperation and Development in Paris, France. She is a volunteer mentor for a youth, inner-city leadership program and sits on the Board of Christie Lake Kids whose mission is to enrich the lives and prospects of economically disadvantaged children.

David Widman serves as a medical advisor to Cloud DX Inc. He is a fellowship trained musculoskeletal radiologist and has trained in and is certified to practice medicine, in both Canada and the United States. Recently, he has contributed as a co-inventor on several US medical related patent submissions.
