These instructions are for students or residents who have **confirmed** electives.

Thank you very much for your interest in the Yukon and we look forward to having you here. Please read this carefully as there are some things you will need to organize before you arrive.

1. Licensing

Contact Yukon Medical Council, Government of Yukon, regarding your resident or student license. Information and forms are on the Yukon Medical Council website: http://www.yukonmedicalcouncil.ca

Thirty (30) business days are required to process applications. Note: You must contact the Yukon Medical Council independently from the Yukon Hospital, as these are different processes.

4. ID Badges

Please let Dr. Greer know if you still have not been assigned a specific preceptor 3 weeks prior to the start of your elective.

6. EMR Access at WGH

If you will be working at the hospital, you are going to require Meditech access. For Meditech access and hospital computer access please contact the hospital main switchboard and ask first for the hospital IT department, then for the 1Health support team.
